Option #1 (Basic)

\$70.00 (using 3" crossarm, without mailbox. Kit comes with mailbox mounting plate)

\$10.00 - 4" x 4" x 6' pressure treated wood post (Recommended)

\$5.00 - Address numbers (1 set for one side of mailbox post) - .93/ea.

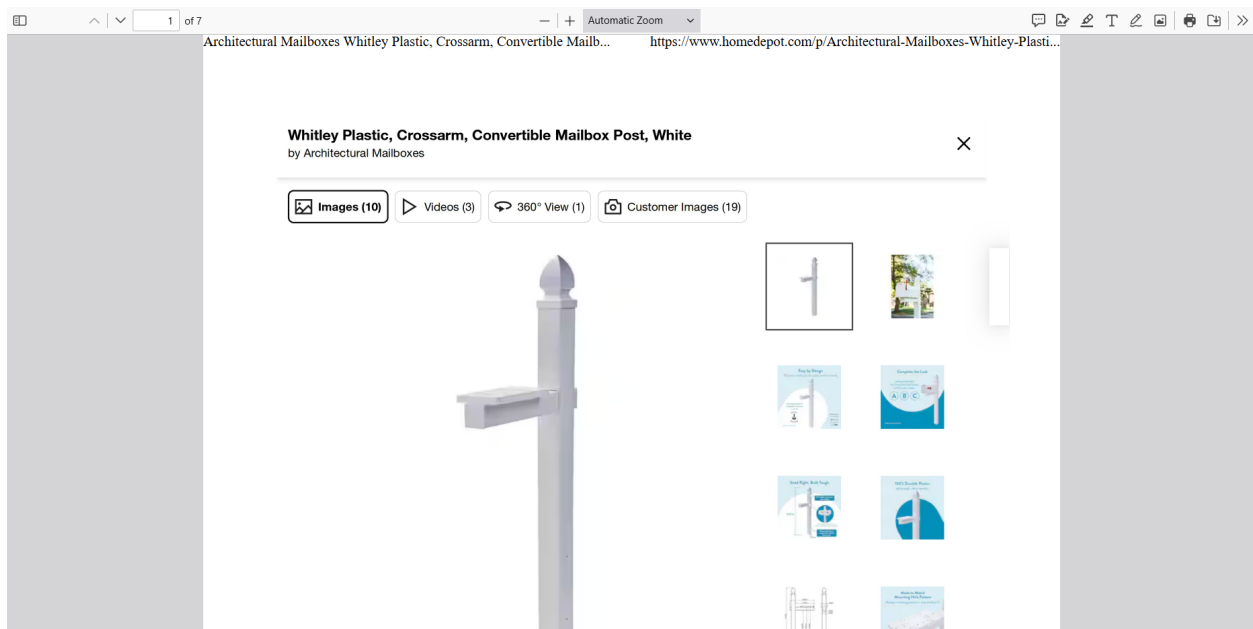
\$1.50 - PVC Glue

\$.50 - Caulk and screws

\$1.00 - Pea gravel

\$50.00 - Labor

Total - \$138.00



Option #2 (Recommended)

\$100.00 - 4" x 4" PVC post sleeve with 5" crossarm. Does not include mailbox.

\$10.00 - 4" x 4" x 6' pressure treated wood post

\$8.00 - Mailbox mounting plate

\$5.00 - Address numbers (1 set for one side of mailbox post) - .93/ea

\$1.50 - PVC Glue

\$.50 - Caulk and screws

\$1.00 - Pea gravel

\$8.00 – Extended top post cover

\$50.00 - Labor

Total - \$184.00



Option #3

Manufacture of 5" x 5" PVC mailbox sleeve

\$37.00 - 5" x 5" x 8' PVC post

\$13.00 – 4" x 4" x 40" PVC cross arm

\$8.00 - Mailbox mounting plate

\$10.00 - 4" x 4" x 6' pressure treated wood post (Recommended)

\$5.00 - Address numbers (1 set for one side of mailbox post) - .93/ea

\$1.50 - PVC Glue

\$.50 - Caulk and screws

\$1.00 - Pea gravel

\$16.36 – Extended top post cover

\$4.50 – End cap cover

\$75.00 – Labor to install and cut holes into 5" post to accept 4" crossarm.

Total - \$171.86

Additional options:
